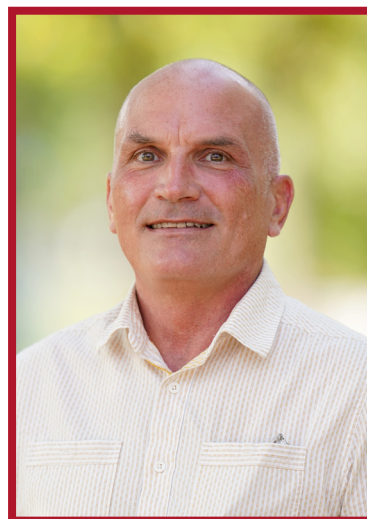

Steve Blumenshine, PhD. currently serves as the Director of the CWI Research & Education Division; at California State University, Fresno.

Dr. Blumenshine leads the efforts in developing and strengthening water research and scholarship at Fresno State in collaboration with external partners and other water stakeholders. These efforts focus on the critical agricultural, rural, urban, and environmental water issues in the San Joaquin Valley, with an awareness and application of the governmental and societal roles in the allocation of overprescribed and stressed water resources.

Dr. Blumenshine has over 20 years of experience in leading Fresno State funded research projects in the San Joaquin Valley on: headwater streams in the Sierra, foothill rivers, reservoirs, and watersheds, the San Joaquin River, flooded Ag fields as conservation habitat in the Central Valley, and the SF Bay-Delta. His international water experience includes two U.S. Fulbright Scholar Awards, and overall includes collaborations in China, Germany, Israel, Switzerland, and Thailand.
