INFORMATION IN THE PUBLISHED PLAN

The plan states that the Tuolumne River is not part of the HRL program and that the Tuolumne River Partners did not sign the March 2022 memorandum of understanding (MOU).

UPDATE AND CLARIFICATION

TID, MID, and SFPUC did not sign the MOU in March 2022; however, they signed it in November 2022. TID also reports that it has an active HRL proposal under evaluation by the State Water Resources Control Board. The State Water Board heard the scientific basis report for the Tuolumne River in fall 2025.

RELEVANCE TO THE UNIFIED WATER PLAN

This information updates the plan's description of Tuolumne River participation in the HRL program. The Blueprint recognizes the Tuolumne River Partners work to develop an HRL program for the San Joaquin River and its tributaries and welcomes opportunities to support advancement of that effort and related projects identified in the Unified Water Plan.
